WHAT TO WEAR AND BRING

Recreation division: Long pants are recommended but not required; tennis shoes are OK but we suggest boots to drain the muck and water. Costumes are welcome!

Applying bug spray prior to your run is recommended. A gear check will be available to store your items such as car keys, cell phone, flip flops, camera and a change of clothes if desired (all participants will receive an event T-shirt). WHEN YOU ARRIVE

Check-in: Check-in will be onsite at the festival area across from McLoone's Boathouse the day of the event from 7:30 a.m. to 30 minutes before the last wave. Please note: This is the only check-in this year. Be sure to bring the enclosed waiver with you. If you're between the ages of 12 and 17, make sure your parent or guardian sign the event waiver and turn it in at check-in. Youth waivers must be notarized. (Notary will be on site.)

Gear check: Gallon-sized plastic bags are available at the gear check tent. If you're bringing your own bag, please limit to a gallon-sized bag.

Line up: Head to the start line a few minutes before your wave time.

Opening ceremony: To kick off the first wave of the day, we'll have a special opening ceremony beginning at approximately 8:30 a.m.

THE ROUTE

We can't wait for you to experience this insanely fun course! New this year, a shortcut option will be available for anyone not wishing to complete the entire course (approximately 5k). Best of all, you don't have to decide ahead of time — just look for signs along the route if you decide to take the shortcut option. Our first aid/medical team will be stationed along the route (courtesy of South Orange First Aid Squad), as well as hydration stations with water and energy drink. Whether you run recreationally or competitively, you're bound to get downright filthy and have a blast every step of the way!

AFTER YOUR RUN

Clean up: Once you cross the finish line head to the hose-down area (courtesy of the West Orange Fire Department) to get rid of the muck and then join us at McCloone's for the post-event party.

Eat, drink and be merry: Enjoy a drink (adults age 21 or over only), a delicious meal and great music at McCloone's Boathouse.

FESTIVITIES AND SPECTATOR INFO

Throughout the day, spectators and participants can catch all the action by watching the start and finish areas, enjoy music and a live DJ, visit our vendors and learn about multiple sclerosis at the MS tent.

Little Muckers Kids Zone: Kids don't have to miss out on all the muck! Send 'em to the children's area, where there will be plenty of opportunities for the little one to get dirty. The area will not contain any deep water obstacles, so no lifeguards will be on duty but volunteers will be present to monitor all the action. Volunteers are only available to assist with crowd control in this area and ensure parents do not leave their children unattended. A parent or guardian must be present to supervise at all times! Children ages 5 to 11 are welcome. There's no need to register in advance but a waiver must be filled out on event day.
